Sustainability & the Tiny Home Movement

The tiny-house movement is an architectural and social movement that advocates living simply in small homes. Fed by a growing number of tv shows, videos and regional festivals, the appetite for all things tiny gathers momentum every year. The City of



SLO’s recent approval of an ordinance allowing tiny homes on wheels in backyards (and pending approvals by SLO county) means that residents finally have the opportunity to take action, but may not know where to begin. We propose an event that will bring together planners, builders, manufacturers, homeowners, local nonprofits, and partners in the fields of sustainable energy and transportation to create an annual event to help move us toward our goals as a community to house more people more sustainably and make progress toward our Net Zero goals.

PROPOSED EVENT: A 3-day Expo (Friday-Sunday) with displays & tours of tiny homes from local and national builders plus a Net Zero Village with displays/vendors in energy/solar; transportation/mobility; kids zone with fun activities. Off-site bike tours.

INSPIRATION & EDUCATION: Tiny Build Workshop for Women (hands on), Short free workshops (during Expo days/times): code implementation; incentives; permitting streamlining; permit application assistance; technical installation (utilities, foundation, access, etc.); funding; lease and “yardshare”; sharing best practices; types of certification (RVIA; NOAH), etc.
